



Imperial Diet in Frankfurt in 822



Albgis, who, having publicly kidnapped the wife of Patrick to the uttermost parts of the kingdom, led her to the harsh yet Christianity of the Moravian nation and by the crime of adultery disgraced the Church of Christ; according to the common authorities we decree,... in order, according to the Holy canonical ordinances, to repent deeply, that is, for three years, except for special feasts, about bread and water, legumes and vegetables, and then for another four years, let him fast similarly for three days each week (and still) for three forty-day fasts, if excessive weakness would not prevent him from fulfilling it in this way, and let him take off his military belt for all the time of living without a wife.

Michael the Drunkard (ὁ Μέθυσος)

Michael presided over a synod in 867 in which Photios and the three other eastern patriarchs excommunicated Pope Nicholas and condemned the Latin filioque clause concerning the procession of the Holy Spirit.






